Guidelines for the communications

Short talks

Each talk is allocated 20 minutes. We kindly request that you limit your presentation to a maximum of 15 minutes to allow time for a short question-and-answer session afterwards.

You can use your own device for the presentation, but a Windows and a MacOS laptop will also be available. In that case, please bring your presentation file on a USB stick or send it to luces@misc.rptu.de.

Flash communications

Each flash is allocated 4 minutes to present your poster, no question-and-answer.

Poster must also be prepared.

Posters

Posters should be prepared in a vertical A0 format and must be ready for display no later than Thursday morning. Coffee breaks and the poster session will be held in the same room, so posters can be displayed (and discussed) throughout the workshop. Please be available for discussion at your poster during the poster session (the award jury may also come!).

Prizes

A jury will award prizes to the two best short talks and the two best poster presentations!
